#### **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

- 1. Send in the completed application and all supporting documents along with a non-refundable \$75.00 application fee.
- 2. Once the application is reviewed, the applicant will be given a telephone/web-cam/in-person interview. Please see the enclosed Admission Policies for more information.
- 3. If admitted, NJUCA will issue a letter of acceptance along with a registration packet.
- 4. If the applicant desires to enroll, please complete the registration packet and submit with a non-refundable \$200.00 registration fee. This fee is per family. Please see the enclosed tuition/fee schedule for additional financial information.

#### APPLICATION PACKET CHECKLIST

For day students, the following items need to be received to complete the application package:

- o Completed Family Information Form
- o For 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade applicants, transcripts that cover all years from 9<sup>th</sup> grade. For middle school and 9<sup>th</sup> grade applicants, transcripts that cover either 5<sup>th</sup> grade (for 6<sup>th</sup> grade applicants) or all the years of middle school prior to the grade you are applying.

- Signed Standard of Community Life
- o Completed Parent Questionnaire

#### **ADMISSION POLICIES**

The following are the policies of NJUCA regarding admittance:

- **A. MISSION STATEMENT:** To provide a solid academic program, rooted in Biblical truth, with an emphasis on developing Christian leadership among students. We envision a school that prepares teenagers to be strong Christian leaders, impacting their school, communities and culture; a school that works with the home and the church to raise up teens who recognize and utilize their God-given gifts; a school that helps to train teens to defend the faith and to spread the awesome news of Jesus Christ to their generation and to pursue the career to which God has called them, standing out among society as a testimony to God's perfect plan.
- **B. NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY:** NJUCA admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available to students at NJUCA. NJUCA does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, scholarships and loan programs, athletic program or other school-administrated programs.
- **C. ADMISSION REQUIREMENT:** NJUCA encourages applicants of good moral character with a passion for learning, variety of talents, and interests. In addition to this, all parents and students must be interviewed as outlined in this policy.
- **D. APPLICATION FOR ENROLLMENT:** An application for enrollment is considered properly submitted when the application forms provided by NJUCA are completed and returned. In addition to the application fee the student's latest report card will be needed. No child will be assigned a position on enrollment lists until the application is completed in full.
- **E. PARENT/STUDENT INTERVIEWS:** An interview of an applicant's parents and student will be conducted by the principal. The purpose of the interview(s) is to:
  - The family beliefs and practices are consistent with the standards and values of NJUCA;
  - The student expresses a desire to attend NJUCA and agrees to live in harmony with school standards;
  - Academic records and/or transcripts of previous school work, health records, and references are reviewed and found to be acceptable under the standard set by NJUCA;
  - Students with a history of behavioral problems have cleared their records with previous schools and now demonstrate a commitment for a changed lifestyle in both personal testimony and character references;
  - Answer questions that parents/students may have regarding NJUCA.

#### F. ADMISSION DECISIONS:

Standard Admission – is offered by NJUCA administration to those students who meet all requirements for enrollment at NJUCA.

Probationary Admission – is set by NJUCA administration due to extenuating circumstances brought about by the student's academic or behavioral profile. This probationary period would vary in length from one term to the entire school year. Disciplinary probation would be established due to past behavioral problems, attitudes expressed during the interview or concerns raised by references. As with academic probation, students placed on disciplinary probation will be monitored during the length of the probation period and evaluation made as to the student's continued enrollment at NJUCA.

New Jersey United Christian Academy seeks to be one of three major influences in your family life. We view the home, the church and our school as three strands of a cord that is not easily broken (Ecclesiastes 4:12). Because of the times and society in which we live, it is imperative that these three institutions work in harmony as we have our faculty, staff and families affirm, on a regular basis, their pledge to the basic principles of faith and conduct, along with their commitment to be in regular worship in a local church. A. STATEMENT OF FAITH: NJUCA has adopted the following as defining its doctrinal basis:

- We believe that there is one sovereign God, eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. (1 Timothy 1:17)
- We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative Word of God for faith and practice. (2 Timothy 3:16)
- We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father and in His personal return in power and glory. (Hebrews 1:1-3)
- We believe and profess that salvation is a gift of God's grace received through personal faith in Jesus Christ. (Ephesians 2:8)
- We believe in the present indwelling ministry of the Holy Spirit, whose intercessory and sanctifying work continually renews the Christian and enables him to live a godly life in conformity with the Scripture. (John 14:15-17)
- We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ as evidenced in the local body of Christ that is the church. (Hebrews 10: 22-25)

#### COMMUNICATE A POSITIVE ATTITUDE: Psalm 1:1; Proverbs 4:24; Ephesians 4:29

- o Refrain from gossip, slander and verbally hurting others.
- o Work to resolve conflict in a manner that pleases God and promotes peace.
- o Keep from mocking and scornful communication

#### UPHOLD A BIBLICAL STANDARD OF MORALITY: Proverbs 2:8-10; Corinthians 6:18-20

- o Abstain from the possession and use of alcohol, tobacco and illegal drugs
- o Refrain from the use of profanity or vulgarity
- o Flee from sexual sin

#### MAINTAIN A GODLY LIFESTYLE: Proverbs 6:10-19; Colossians 3: 8-19; 1 Peter 1:3-8

- o Be honest and trustworthy in relationships and responsibilities
- O Seek to build faith and the Fruit of the Spirit in self and others
- Promote and practice forgiveness
